

The Blaydon Race Access Policy Statement

In this Policy Statement the term 'Disability' has the same meaning as the Equality Act 2010.

The Blaydon Race recognises its obligations for reasons of the Equality Act 2010 with regards to disability.

The Blaydon Race will make every reasonable effort to accommodate those with disabilities who may wish to compete competitively in the Blaydon Race.

The Blaydon Race will, when a competitive quorum of para-athletes come forward, facilitate a suitable category within the Race to accommodate that group of athletes.

To enable The Blaydon Race to make reasonable adjustments so that it can accommodate those with disabilities, it requires, that during the application process, para-athletes inform The Blaydon Race of their disability so that a competent individual assessment can be made and when indicated, reasonable adjustments implemented.
